Ms. Coldrey Lo:

Chief Superintendent Serge Therriault in the attached letter of 12 March 2010 told me that “Should you not be satisfied with this reply, a complaint by mail can be made to the Commission for Public Complaints Against the RCMP...” I did so on 18 May 2011. Ms. Andrée Leduc on 2 June 2011 informed me that the Commission was unable to consider the evidence which I had put at my web site (see Block 10). Attached is a hard copy of that evidence.

As supervisor of Ms. Leduc, please reconsider my complaint in light of this evidence submitted in hard copy. Also please informed me of the regulation referred to by Ms. Leduc in a telephone conversation with me on 9 June 2011 which prevented her from considering the evidence.

I would also like to amend block 19 to read instead “Serge Therriault, Chief Superintendent and Stan Burke, Superintendent.”

I will summarize my case to the Commission: I asked the RCMP to investigate an offence; the RCMP refused; and I am asking the Commission to review that decision. I would suggest that you discuss the case with your legal counsel.
